Specialty Services

Provides assessment, counselling and treatment services for people with specific moderate to severe mental health disorders.

We respect your right to privacy. We will ask you about involving your family in your care. Sharing information and working with your family and care providers will ensure you receive the best care.

Seniors Mental Health & Substance Use Services

Provides specialized assessments, treatment, case management and community support as well as caregiver support for people 65 years and older. Multi-disciplinary teams serve individuals with dementia and other mental health and/or substance use concerns.

Services may include:

- Mental health & competency assessments
- Medication administration, review & monitoring
- Care coordination & referrals
- Self-management supports
- Life skills education & support
- Family education & support



Early Psychosis Intervention

Provides treatment and support for people who may be experiencing their first episode of psychosis. Services may include:

- Screening & assessments
- Medication administration, review & monitoring
- Counselling, treatment & recovery plans
- Crisis intervention
- Life skills education & support
- Self-management support
- Relapse prevention
- Bridging youth and adult mental health services
- Care coordination & referrals
- Linking community services with hospital
- Community education

Eating Disorders Treatment Services

Provides individual and group therapy for people diagnosed with a severe / life threatening eating disorder. Referral from a family physician is required. Services may include:

- Psychological & psychiatric assessment & treatments
- Group counselling & support
- Individual & family counselling & education
- Interventions to:
 - Initiate renourishment
 - Increase body weight
 - Promote medical stabilization

Developmental Disability Mental Health Services

Provides team-based mental health services for individuals aged 14 years or older who are diagnosed with developmental disabilities, including those with challenging behaviours and other complex needs. Services may include:

- Screening & assessment
- Treatment & consultation
- Follow-up services
- Referrals to other community services



Interior Health Children's Assessment Network

Provides assessment and diagnostic services for children and youth with autism spectrum disorder, fetal alcohol spectrum disorder and other complex developmental conditions. A referral from a medical professional is needed.

Assessment services are delivered by a combination of Interior Health staff and contracted services located throughout the Interior Health region.
