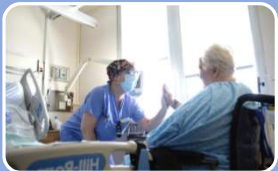

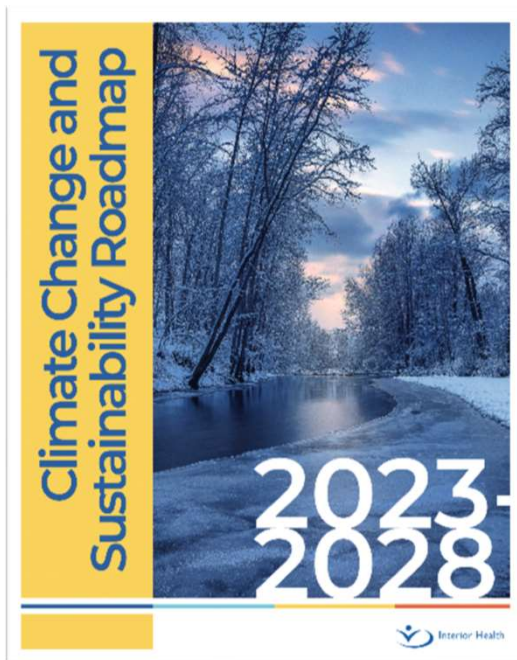

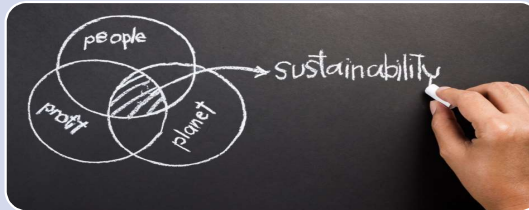
Setting Our Future Direction
