Grade 6

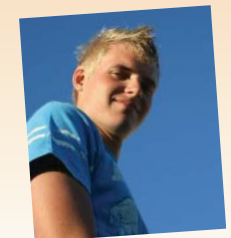

- This vaccine is given only if the child has not previously had the vaccine
- * Varicella vaccine is given if not previously immunized OR not had the disease OR had the disease <12 months of age
