Yellow substance sold as down contaminated with a toxic combination of benzodiazepines and fentanyl. Substance tested at ANKORS

Drug checking is continuing to identify yellow substance contaminated with a toxic combination of benzodiazepine and fentanyl. People continue to report passing out for an extended periods of time after using. Substance tested at ANKORS

For your safety:

- Buddy up when you are using, stay 2 meters (6 ft) from your buddy to remain physically distanced, but remember using with a buddy is safer than using alone!
- Use at an overdose prevention or supervised consumption site if one is near you.
- **Get your drugs checked** see service information below.
- Avoid using different drugs at the same time or using drugs and alcohol together.
- Don't use alone. Leave door unlocked. Tell someone to check on you.
- If you feel you must use while alone, consider using the <u>Lifeguard app</u> which can connect you with emergency medical dispatchers in the event of an overdose. Download at the <u>App Store</u> or <u>Google Play</u>.
- Test by using a small amount, then go slow.
- Carry a Naloxone kit and know how to use it.

Know the signs of overdose and how to respond:

- Recognize the signs of an OD: slow or no breathing, gurgling or gasping, lips/fingertips turning blue, difficult to rouse (awaken), non-responsive.
- Call 9-1-1 immediately. It is still safe (and important) to use emergency services during the COVID -19 pandemic
- Give naloxone (Narcan) if you have it, open airway and give rescue breaths.
