Interior Health celebrates Kamloops walk-in-Wednesday

KAMLOOPS – Interior Health is encouraging everyone who is eligible to receive their COVID-19 vaccine on Wednesday at the Tournament Capital Centre in Kamloops, where there will be live entertainment, therapy dogs and free smoothies.

Throughout British Columbia on Wed., Aug. 4, eligible individuals across the province can walk-into any COVID-19 immunization clinic without an appointment and receive their first or second dose of vaccine.

Drop-In Vaccinations

Event:	Walk-in Wednesday in Kamloops
Location:	Tournament Capital Centre, Kamloops
Time:	Wed. Aug. 4, 2021, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
Who:	Anyone eligible for their first or second dose of COVID-19 (anyone who received their first dose 49+ days earlier is eligible).

Musicians from the group Beyond Brass, and calling themselves the ‘Safe Sectionals’ during the pandemic, will be performing starting at 11 a.m. to celebrate the city’s vaccination progress, and further encourage fellow Kamloopsians to walk-in or dance-in for their first or second dose.

Therapy dogs from St. John Ambulance will be on-site from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. for anyone who needs support getting their vaccination.

Additionally, the City of Kamloops has organized to hand-out coupons for free smoothies for the first 100 people who get their vaccinations during Walk-in Wednesday at the Tournament Capital Centre.

Interior Health continues to offer first and second doses of the COVID-19 vaccine daily in Kamloops, on a drop-in basis and by appointment. The Kamloops immunization clinic at the Tournament Capital Centre is open Mon., Wed., Fri. – Sun. from 10 a.m. – 3 p.m., and Tues. & Thurs., 11:30 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Ongoing immunization clinics

People can get their first or second dose of a COVID-19 vaccine by dropping in to an IH immunization clinic or by making an appointment.
