 - If you are logging in from outside the IHA Network, you will need to provide your IH username and password thru the 2 Factor Authentication (2FA) process. You will be asked to provide a passcode that will be sent to you via text or email.



When you enter iLearn, your “My Learning Opportunities” will be displayed. Click on the “Required” tab to display the courses that have been requested for you to complete.

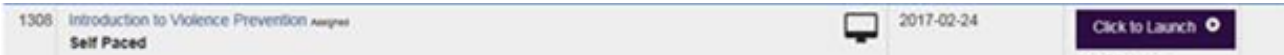






Launching a Course in iLearn

1. Click the  icon to launch the course.

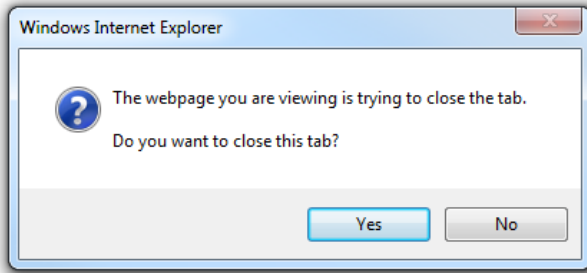
