- Visiting hours are from 2:00 pm to 8:00 pm daily.
- For patients comfort, keep visits short and no more than two visitors at a time.
- Visitors should be free of the flu, cold, or cough.
- Visitors parking is available in the pay parking area.
- ***No smoking is allowed in hospital, or on hospital property.***

Prior to Surgery, you must organize:

- transportation to and from the hospital
- a caregiver, if necessary
- an interpreter, if needed
- equipment which may be required after surgery (i.e. crutches, walker, etc.)
- a family member or friend to assist with meals, housekeeping and personal care once you are at home, if necessary

Notify your surgeon's office if you develop a fever, cold or illness prior to your surgery.

The Day Before Surgery

Call the hospital at 558-1378 between 12:00 and 2:00 pm for time of admission.

Please be on Time

There are forms to be completed, and sometimes other preparations to be made. Occasionally, your operation may be a bit later than anticipated. At other times it may be earlier.

On the evening prior to surgery, patients must not smoke or eat after midnight. (Including, chewing gum and candy)

*Patients, including children over 12 months, are allowed **only 8 ounces of one of the following:** water, apple juice, black tea or black coffee up to **four** hours before surgery. No creamers or milk. If these instructions are not followed, your surgery will be cancelled.*

Breast fed or formula fed infants (up to 12 months of age) may feed six hours before surgery.

The Morning of Surgery

- Have a bath or shower. Remove **all jewellery and piercings** and leave it at home. Remove all make-up and nail polish.
- Do not bring credit cards or more than \$20.00 cash to the hospital.

Bring

- only insulin and inhalers
- housecoat, slippers, walking shoes and toilet articles
