# How to use an Handihaler®

#### Patient Information

### Usage

- Only remove ONE capsule from the package just before you put it into the Handihaler<sup>®</sup>.
- Make sure your hands are dry.
- DO NOT SWALLOW THE CAPSULE.
- Steps 9 to 11 are repeated in the directions to ensure you have taken all of the medication.
- If you breathe into the Handihaler<sup>®</sup> after it is loaded, throw the capsule away. Put a new one in and follow steps 7 to 14.

#### Cleaning

- Wipe the mouthpiece with a clean, dry, cloth or tissue.
- If you don't get a new Handihaler with each prescription then you will need to wash it every month. Follow the step by step instructions that come with your Handihaler<sup>®</sup>. You will need to replace it every year.

#### Storage

- Keep the package in a dry place at room temperature.
- Keep away from direct sunlight or heat.
- Do not store in the bathroom.

#### When to get more capsules

- Prescriptions will last you 30 days. Samples from the doctor are different so be sure to check how many doses you have.
- Check the expiry date on the box or the package of capsules.
- Start using a new prescription of capsules when the old one is finished or expired.
