The \$367 million Interior Heart and Surgical Centre (IHSC) Project is an important part of building patient care in the Interior and will benefit patients across the health authority by being able to provide the highest level of medical care ever seen in the Interior in an integrated critical care facility supported by a full range of clinical supports closer to where people live. The surgical building will provide a permanent location for cardiac surgical services and programs at Kelowna General Hospital (KGH). The centre will have state-of-the-art surgical facilities, a medical device reprocessing department, cardiac intensive care and post-operative recovery.

- Interior demolition within the Pandosy Building will commence
- Preparation begins for exterior structural demolition of Pandosy

- Work continues on interior demolition of the Pandosy Building
- All of the exterior scaffolding will be taken down
