

## Penticton Regional Hospital Phase 2 construction underway

Interior Health would like to share the following information regarding access to Penticton Regional Hospital (PRH), now that the David E. Kampe Tower is open and major renovations are underway to the PRH emergency department as part of Phase 2 of the tower project.

As of Dec. 1, 2019 only emergency and labour and delivery patients will have access through the emergency department entrance off Carmi Avenue.

All other patients should use the main entrance to PRH, the front doors of the David E. Kampe Tower off Government Street, or the entrance from the parkade, to access the hospital.

Services and programs, such as the outpatient lab, cardiology, respiratory and X-ray can be accessed through the David E. Kampe Tower entrance.

## Visitor parking available in new parkade

Visitor parking is available on Levels 1 , 2 and 3 of the parkade attached to the David E. Kampe Tower.

Payment for parking is by license plate number and there are ticket machines located in the parkade elevator shelters and inside the David E. Kampe Tower.

There are loading zone parking stalls located in front of the David E. Kampe Tower entrance if necessary.

If you are coming to the hospital for an appointment and are concerned about walking distance please present to a volunteer desk on Level 1 of the David E. Kampe Tower to ask for assistance.
