

## Process for Physicians/Nurse Practitioners to Obtain Childhood Vaccine from Health Centres

- 1. Review BCCDC CDC Manual, Chapter 2 Immunization Program prior to ordering vaccine.

## How to Obtain Vaccine from Public Health Centre

- Obtain a Physician/NP: Childhood Vaccine Order Form from your local Health Centre or via <u>www.interiorhealth.ca</u> > Physicians > Immunizations > Immunizations Resources & Tools>Physician Immunization Program
- 5. Order one month's supply at a time. Do not overstock.
- 6. Fax **Physician/NP: Childhood Vaccine Order Form** to local Health Centre Attention: Prevention Services Assistant.
- 7. Maintain cold chain at all times. Bring a cooler, bubble wrap and ice packs to the Health Centre for vaccine pick up during your designated time. Refer to the Communicable Disease Control Immunization Program Manual Section VI <u>Management of Biologicals</u> for information on cold chain, equipment recommendations, handling of biological products and management of a cold chain incident.
- Review childhood immunization records prior to vaccine administration. You may use CVP
  Request for Records available from your local Health Centre or via <a href="www.interiorhealth.ca">www.interiorhealth.ca</a> >
  Physicians > Immunizations > Immunizations Resources & Tools > Physician Immunization
  Program
- Report back to the Health Centre immediately on vaccine administered using the
   Physician/NP Report: Childhood Immunization available from your local Health Centre or
   via www.interiorhealth.ca > Physicians > Immunizations > Immunizations Resources &
   Tools>Physician Immunization Program (This will ensure timely input of immunization data in
   the Health Centre electronic client record)
  - 10. Report Adverse Events Following Immunization (AEFI) to the local Health Centre using Adverse Events Following Immunization Form available at <a href="http://www.bccdc.ca/discond/CDSurveillanceForms/default.htm">http://www.bccdc.ca/discond/CDSurveillanceForms/default.htm</a>
  - 11. Report any cold chain incidents to the local Health Centre as outlined in <a href="Equipment Malfunction or Power Failure"><u>Equipment Malfunction or Power Failure</u></a> available at <a href="http://www.bccdc.ca/imm-vac/ForHealthProfessionals/coldchain/default.htm"><u>http://www.bccdc.ca/imm-vac/ForHealthProfessionals/coldchain/default.htm</u></a>
