## Leave your mark on the David E. Kampe Tower

Construction of the David E. Kampe Tower is approaching the halfway point and to mark this significant milestone, we're inviting members of the public to sign their name on a structural steel beam.

A drop-in beam signing event will be open to all South Okanagan community members at Penticton Regional Hospital on **October 26 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.**

A public Topping Off Ceremony will also be held the next day, on **October 27, 2017 at 11 a.m.** featuring remarks from Health Minister Adrian Dix and representatives from Interior Health, the Okanagan-Similkameen Regional Hospital District, and the South Okanagan Similkameen Medical Foundation. To conclude the ceremony, the signed beam will be hoisted and placed in its permanent location in the David E. Kampe Tower.

Both events will take place at Penticton Regional Hospital, outside of the construction site, beside the South Parking Lot in front of MOOG & Friends Hospice House. Signs will be posted to direct attendees.
