# Mental Health & Substance Use Services

We invite you to connect with our Access Services program at your local Mental Health & Substance Use Centre for more information and links to mental health or substance use services that best meet your needs.

### Mental Health Treatment, Support & Recovery Services

Provides ongoing illness management, support and recovery service for people experiencing serious & persistent mental illness.

We respect your right to privacy. We will ask you about involving your family in your care. Sharing information and working with your family and care providers will ensure you receive the best care.

# Treatment, Support & Recovery Program

Provides treatment and support to help people with major mental illness and substance use concerns on their journey to mental wellness and recovery. Services may include:

- Screening & assessments
- Medication administration, review & monitoring
- Counselling, treatment & recovery plans
- Crisis intervention
- Life skills support & education
- Self-management support
- Relapse prevention
- Care coordination & referrals

# Therapeutic Volunteer Program

Provides people unable to enter vocational or supported education programs with financial support for volunteer positions.

#### Supported Employment Services

Services may include:

- Specialized assessments & career planning
- Job skills training
- Transitional & supported employment services
- Work experience
- Consumer-run businesses or co-operatives

### Clubhouse

Clubhouse is a membership driven drop-in rehabilitation program. Individuals and staff work side-by-side to manage the operation of the Clubhouse, including clerical services, food services, program activities and outreach services. Referral from a Mental Health and Substance Use program is needed.



#### Intensive Case Management

Provides team-based care coordination for people with severe mental health and/or substance use concerns.

Services are provided in the community and are tailored to the person's needs. The program includes services offered by the Treatment, Support & Recovery Program plus:

- Assistance to find & keep housing
- Primary Care
- Outreach

### Assertive Community Treatment

Provides team-based care for people with multiple complex needs and mental illness and/or substance use concerns.

The teams provide client-directed care, assertive outreach and comprehensive, continuous service delivery. The program includes services offered by Treatment, Support & Recovery Program plus:

- Assistance to find & keep housing
- Primary Care
- Outreach
- Money management & employment
- Psychosocial rehabilitation
- Court liaison
