

Extreme levels of fentanyl and benzodiazepines found in drugs tested across the region









START LOW

GO SLOW!

Looks Like: Down samples of all colors and texture

Sold as: Down, fentanyl

Contains: Up to 55% fentanyl (Average is +/- 10%)

Up to 25% etizolam (Average is +/- 1 to 2%)

Risk: High risk of overdose, High risk of fatal overdose

Long periods of sleep and drowsiness likely Unresponsiveness to Naloxone possible

In effect until: February 26th 2022

No matter what or how you use (smoking, snorting, injecting) take steps to prevent overdose:

- Get your drugs checked find locations at drugchecking.ca
- Be aware of increased risk if mixing with other drugs, including alcohol
- Use with others around or at an Overdose Prevention Site (OPS)
- Start with a small amount and space out your doses
- Carry naloxone and know how use it
