DOWN (fentanyl, benzos) found in METHAMPHETAMINE



Fent + Benzos Found in Meth

Looks Like: Clear/White Shards, Crystals, Powder

Sold as: Meth, Side, Methamphetamine

Contains: Methamphetamine

Down (caffeine, mannitol, fentanyl, benzodiazepine)

Risk: Risk of overdose and death

Symptoms: Side effects include: Drowsiness, Itchiness, Memory

Loss, Nausea

In effect until: April 29th 2022

No matter what or how you use (oral, smoking, snorting, injecting) take steps to prevent overdose:

- Before using, get your drugs checked to find out if your meth contains fentanyl. Find locations at drugchecking.ca
- Be aware of unexpected side-effects
- Be aware of risk if mixing with other drugs, including alcohol
- Use with others around or at an Overdose Prevention Site (OPS)
- Start with a small amount and space out your doses
- Carry naloxone and know how use it
