

DRUG ALERT Kamloops



Tablet sold as Percocet contains fentanyl or a fentanyl analog



Looks Like:	White Percocet tablet, "TEC" with a score line on the back	
Sold as:	Percocet tablet (oxycodone)

This is a counterfeit (fake) tablet sold as Percocet. **It does not contain oxycodone.** It contains an unknown amount of fentanyl. Using illicit tablets is not recommended due to the very high risk of overdose. Be aware of risk of fakes, if not purchasing from a pharmacy.

Have a tablet that looks like this? call/text: 250-299-7219 to get it checked before using.

Consider these additional tips if you are going to use drugs

- Find drug checking locations at www.drugchecking.ca
- Carry naloxone and know how to use it.
- Be aware of risks if mixing with other drugs, including alcohol.
- Use with others around when possible.
- Start with a very small amount and space out your doses.
