Kamloops

Tablet sold as Percocet contains fentanyl or a fentanyl analog



- Looks Like: White Percocet tablet, “TEC” with a score line on the back
- Sold as: Percocet tablet (oxycodone)
- Contains: Fentanyl or a fentanyl analog
- Risk: Very high risk of overdose
- In effect until: February 18, 2025

This is a counterfeit (fake) tablet sold as Percocet. It does not contain oxycodone. It contains an unknown amount of fentanyl. Using illicit tablets is not recommended due to the very high risk of overdose. Be aware of risk of fakes, if not purchasing from a pharmacy.

Have a tablet that looks like this? call/text: 250-299-7219 to get it checked before using.

Consider these additional tips if you are going to use drugs

- Find drug checking locations at www.drugchecking.ca
- Carry naloxone and know how to use it.
- Be aware of risks if mixing with other drugs, including alcohol. ←
- Use with others around when possible.
- Start with a very small amount and space out your doses.
