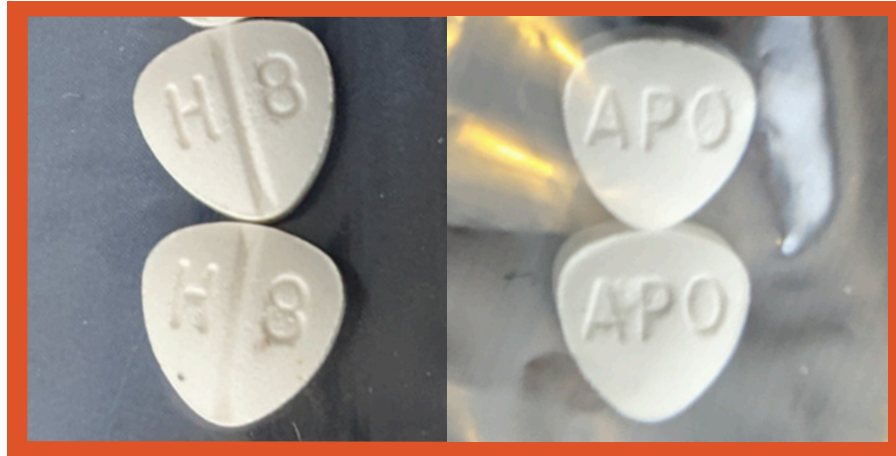


# DRUG ALERT

## Nelson



**Counterfeit Dilaudid tablets contain a fentanyl analog**



Looks Like: Dilaudid tablet - 8|H / APO

Sold as: Dilaudid/Dillies/Hydromorphone

Contains: N-propionyl parafluoronorfentanyl  
(a fentanyl analog)

Risk: High risk of overdose

In effect until: May 22nd 2025

**Check your  
drugs before  
using!**

This is a counterfeit (fake) tablet sold as Dilaudid. It **does not** contain hydromorphone. It contains an unknown amount a drug related to fentanyl. Using illicit tablets is not recommended due to the heightened risk of overdose. Be aware of risk of fakes, if not purchasing from a pharmacy.

**Have a tablet that looks like this? call/text: 236-972-7080 to get it checked before using.**

### Consider these additional tips if you are going to use drugs

- Find drug checking locations at [www.drugchecking.ca](http://www.drugchecking.ca)
- Carry naloxone and know how to use it.
- Be aware of risks if mixing with other drugs, including alcohol.
- Use with others around when possible.
- Start with a very small amount and space out your doses.
