## Kamloops


**DOWN contains Cafentanil and Fluorofentanyl**

Looks Like: Brown Granules

Sold as: Down, Fentanyl

Contains: Carfentanil (1%)  
Fluorofentanyl (less than 1%)


Risk: Extreme risk of overdose and fatal overdose.  
Smoking is not safer than injecting.



Fluorofentanyl is a fentanyl analogue that can be up to 2x stronger than fentanyl.  
Carfentanil is a fentanyl analogue that is 50-100x stronger than fentanyl. The amount of carfentanil in this sample is roughly equivalent to 50-100% of fentanyl per point (100 mg).



**If you have a drug that looks like this, get it tested before using. Drug checking is available in Kamloops Monday to Friday from 8:30-12:00 and 1:00-4:30 at Ask Wellness- 433 Tranquille Road (back entrance)**



### Consider these additional tips if you are going to use drugs

- Find more drug checking locations at [www.drugchecking.ca](http://www.drugchecking.ca)
- Be aware of risks if mixing with other drugs, including alcohol
- Use with others around or at an Overdose Prevention Site
- Start with a small amount and wait before taking more
- Space out your doses
- Carry naloxone and know how to use it
