



There have been multiple drug poisonings (overdoses) in Kelowna.

In effect until November 26 2025

Start Low + Go Slow Reach out for a buddy so no one uses alone!

Multiple samples of Down (fentanyl) have recently tested positive for medetomidine in Kelowna. In addition, drug checking has found new benzodiazepines (ethylbromazolam, ethylflualprazoam and phenazolam) cooccurring with fentanyl and medetomidine.

The effects of these drugs, alone or combined together are unpredictable and increase the risk of overdose.

No matter what or how you use (smoking, snorting, injecting) take steps to prevent overdose:

- Get your drugs checked find locations at drugchecking.ca
- Be aware of increased risk if mixing with other drugs, including alcohol
- Use with others around or at an Overdose Prevention Site (OPS).
- Start with a small amount and space out your doses
- Carry naloxone and know how use it
