Drug sold as Methamphetamine contains MDMA

Looks Like: White powder

Sold as: Methamphetamine, crystal meth, side

Contains: MDMA

Risk: Unexpected effects, drowsiness, confusion



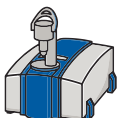
MDMA- commonly known as “molly” or “ecstasy” is a potent central nervous system stimulant that triggers the neurotransmitters serotonin and dopamine.

People who may be exposed to this substance should know that it can cause unexpected effects that may put their safety at risk. For example, people who use meth to stay awake and alert may instead feel drowsy, confused, or less aware of what is happening around them.



If you have a drug that looks like this get it tested before using. Drug checking is available here:

Consider these additional tips if you are going to use drugs

- Find more drug checking locations at www.drugchecking.ca
- Be aware of risks if mixing with other drugs, including alcohol
- Use with others around or at an Overdose Prevention Site
- Start with a small amount and wait before taking more
- Space out your doses
- Carry naloxone and know how to use it
- Call 211 or visit bc211.ca to find services near you
