How to use a Twisthaler®

Usage

- Do not shake the Twisthaler[®] before using.
- If you breathe into the Twisthaler® after taking the cap off, you will need to put the cap back on and follow steps I to 7.
 You will not receive a double dose.

Cleaning

- Wipe the mouthpiece with a clean, dry, cloth or tissue after you take your dose.
- Never use water.

Storage

- Keep the cap on when not in use.
- Keep it in a dry place at room temperature.
- Keep it away from direct sunlight or heat.

When to get a new Twisthaler®

- Once you take your first dose of medication it should be used within 2 months.
- Check the dose counter and the expiry date on the Twisthaler[®].
- Every time you twist the cap off and take a puff the dose counter counts down by I.
- When the counter shows "01" this will be your last dose.
- When the Twisthaler® is empty the cap locks and the counter reads "00".
- Start a new inhaler when the old one is locked or expired.

How to use a Twisthaler® (continued)



I. Twist cap off.



2. Breathe out, away from the Twisthaler® to the end of a normal breath.



3. Put the Twisthaler® between your teeth and seal your lips around it. Do not block the air vents. Breathe in fast, until your lungs are full.



4. Remove the Twisthaler® and hold your breath for 10 seconds, if you can. Breathe out.



5. Push the cap down and twist until you hear it click.



6. Rinse, gargle and spit out.
