

WHAT IS CHALK LUNG?

Chalk lung is a condition that effects the lungs. It is caused by injecting or smoking drugs that are cut with fillers such as Talc Mineral, Corn Starch, and Chalk.



SYMPTOMS OF CHALK LUNG

- Shortness of Breath
- Chest Tightness
- Body Weakness
- Cough
- Phlegm
- Night Sweats
- Unexplained Weight Loss

HOW TO AVOID IT

Can only be prevented through proper filtration. Try to use a Steri-Filt or sterile cotton
