

## Completing the Consent for School Immunization Form for Secondary Students

Students and their parents/guardians/representatives are encouraged to discuss consent for immunization together.

	Review the name, address and any other personal information on the "Consent for School Immunization" form to make sure it is correct and add any missing information.
	Read and complete the Parent/Guardian/Representative Section on the front of the form. If a student is going to give their own consent, they will fill out the Mature Minor Consent portion of the form with the nurse at the time of immunization.
	Review the Immunization History on the back of the consent form. If the information in this section is not up to date and you have received vaccines outside of Interior Health Public Health, please provide a copy of the immunization record to your local health centre. A copy can be attached to the consent. Consent for immunization is valid for 2 years, unless the student cancels it (or a parent/guardian/representative if involved in consent process). Refusals are reviewed regularly, and vaccines may be re-offered then or as part of a public health response.

## **Mature Minor Consent**

Students can provide Mature Minor Consent to immunization as per the legislation under the Infants Act. Students who demonstrate an understanding of the benefits and risks of a health service can consent or refuse that service independent of a parent or representative.
