

# **Specimen Collection Considerations for Locations**

### Parking, Traffic Flow:

- Ideally more than one ingress/egress point.
- Choose sites with adequate parking.
- Choose sites where there are no construction disruptions which impact traffic flow to the location.

#### Logistics:

- Gazebo or tent required to provide shade to staff- to be coordinated through the Measles Response Coordination Committee (MRCC).
- Signage: wayfinding directional signage to guide people to the appropriate entrance and exit points, prominent signage indicating operating hours, contact information, etc.
- The clinical team will need to consider if they will require power at the testing site. If requested the respective FM team will be required to assess feasibility.

## **Leasing/Contractual Implications:**

- Select sites where IH is the sole occupant and/or owner to minimize disruption to other tenants.
- Contractual amendments will be required for leased facilities.
