- Oral health tips on how to reduce the risk of developing cavities
- Check and count your child's teeth
- Demonstrate effective toothbrushing and flossing
- Application of fluoride varnish to help protect your child's teeth
- Discuss the importance of routine dental visits
- Take-home resources
