Physicians are trained to keep people healthy and to help patients when they are sick or injured.

Nurses work with physicians and other health care professionals to care for patients when they are sick or injured.

Nursing Unit Clerks work in the hospital and help each medical unit run smoothly.

Support Services people work in all health care facilities as cleaners and food services staff.

Patient Porters assist and transport patients, their belongings, and more to and from different locations in the hospital.

Medical Lab Assistants take blood and other samples from patients and perform routine lab tests.

Health Care Assistants provide support to clients with activities of daily living such as getting dressed, bathing and enjoying a meal.

Medical Imaging professionals use technology to take images inside patients' bodies so physicians can see what is causing illness or injury - like getting an x-ray of a broken bone.

Volunteers complement the care provided by our professionals and are important members of the Interior Health Care Team.
