## Health Care-Associated Infection Rates

**3.1.2** Health care-associated infections are tracked, information is analyzed to identify outbreaks and trends, and this information is shared throughout the organization.

### Infection Prevention & Control

How are infection rates monitored?

Infection Control Professionals (ICPs) monitor for antimicrobial resistant organisms, and for infections including

- *Clostridioides difficile* (CDI)
- Bloodstream infections
- Surgical Site and Central Line Infections

How are the surveillance results used?

- ICPs provide monthly unit reports, site-level Hand Hygiene compliance results and quarterly trending reports
- The results guide QI actions based on expected results and best practice recommendations
