Re: New Molecular Assay for Measles

On July 14th, 2025, Interior Health will introduce measles testing on nasopharyngeal (NP) swabs, throat swabs and urine samples using a new molecular assay at the Kelowna General Hospital (KGH) microbiology lab.

## **Important Information**

For diagnosis of acute measles infection, a respiratory specimen (eg: nasopharyngeal **OR** throat swab) **AND** urine should be collected for molecular testing at KGH.

- Airborne, Droplet & Contact Precautions are required when collecting measles specimens

Specimen type	Collection Container
REQUIRED, one of either:	
Nasopharyngeal swab	UTM-RT MINI barcoof multum  or: Viruses, Chilamydia, Mycoplasma 8 Urayalsana 9 Urayalsana
OR	Red-top Copan UTM for NP swab
Throat swab	CC ( NV)
	Blue-top Copan UTM for throat swab
REQUIRED: Urine	SIMIL PACES NAMED AND STORY OF THE PACES NAME
	Sterile container for urine

Submit an IH Laboratory Requisition with the specimens and indicate specimen source and "Measles PCR" in the "OTHER TESTS" section. Example: OTHER TESTS - Standing Orders Include expiry & frequency

ECG
FIT (Age 50-74 asymptomatic q2y) Copy to Colon Screening Program

Urine - Measles PCR

Throat swab - Measles PCR

FIT No copy to Colon Screening Program

## **Action Required**

- Refrigerate samples for measles testing and submit to your local IH laboratory as soon as possible after collection
- Use Airborne, Droplet & Contact Precautions when collecting measles specimens

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
