



List Options	
Patient List	My Admitted, Rounds, Outpatient, Emergency
Find Patient	Search for inpatient by name or account number
Find by Loc	Select facility and location to display current inpatients
Coverage	Select physicians or location for coverage
Restore Acct	Use to restore removed accounts
Preferences	Set your default patient list, facility and location
Log Off	Log off WebMT
Browsing Options	
Select Visit	Displays all visits for the selected patient, and select by visit
Summary	Displays Allergies/ Adverse Reaction
Reg Info	Displays basic registration and demographic information
Results	Displays results by day
Vital Signs	Displays most recent Patient Vitals in 8 hour increments
I & O	Displays intake and output
Meds	Displays patient Meds - active, pending and discontinued
Labs	Displays lab tests resulted during the patient's visit. Scanned results are also viewable
Micro	Displays last Microbiology results
Reports/Notes	Displays reports and notes from EMR
Sign	Disabled at this time – Future functionality

Helpful Hints


- ❖ The data in WebMT mirrors the data in Meditech.
- ❖ Comparing WebMT side-by-side with the workstation can help build your knowledge of how to use the WebMT application.
- ❖ Following any setup change to “allow” Cookies for Safari, the iPhone must be restarted for changes to take effect.
- ❖ Use the iPhone bookmark option to send the Mobile Rounding link to the home screen.



- ❖ Pressing and holding down the Meditech icon and clicking on the “x” to display the “Delete” option allows deleting the icon.



- ❖ Clear the Safari history, cookies and cache by going to Settings/Safari/Security option.

Meditech WebMT

WebMT is a Meditech web-based application which provides Physicians access to Inpatient, Outpatient and Emergency Patient Lists. In addition, the user can access clinical data within the past 3 days for patients on these lists.

This web-based application is most useful to physicians as a Rounding Tool. It does not replace accessing the complete EMR of a patient.

Interior Health has installed Meditech Pocket PC web software and has branded it "WebMT".

Clinical information, such as lab results and reports are delivered wirelessly to your tablet or Smartphone.

Access is available from anywhere there is a WiFi or 3G internet connection.

This document provides an overview along with descriptions of the routines available when using WebMT.

Access Requirements

Physicians must register with IMIT to obtain access to WebMT.

To obtain the application form call the Service Desk at 1-855-242-1300.

Only physicians with appropriate Interior Health credentials will be granted access.

It will take three working days to process the application.

Minimum Requirements

Internet Access over a Wifi or 3G cellular network.

PDA or SmartPhone running MS Windows Mobile version 5 & Microsoft Pocket Internet Explorer

iPhone and iPad with most current version of Safari

Android device with Google Chrome

Accessing WebMT

Follow these steps to access WebMT on the smartphone device:

webmt.interiorhealth.ca



1. Open the Internet Browser and type this link in the address field: webmt.interiorhealth.ca

- Select SmartPhone Login



2. Enter your standard Interior Health log on **User Name** and **Password** when prompted.



3. After you successfully log in, select the list or function you wish use by selecting from the scrolling buttons at the bottom of the display.

Button Selections include:

- ✓ My Admitted
- ✓ Rounds
- ✓ Outpatient
- ✓ Emergency
- ✓ Find Patient
- ✓ Find by Loc
- ✓ Coverage
- ✓ Restore Acct
- ✓ Sign



4. From the Patient Lists, click on the patient name to open the patient chart.

5. To find a patient not in your lists, use Find Patient

6. Scroll the Button Bar at the bottom of the display to the left to locate the "Find Patient" button.



7. To begin the search, enter the patient name or account number and press Search.

8. Tap the patient name to open the EMR.

9. The scrollable button bar at the bottom of the display will provide additional browsing options within the patient chart:

- ✓ Select Visit
- ✓ Summary
- ✓ Reg Info
- ✓ Results
- ✓ Vital Signs
- ✓ I & O
- ✓ Meds
- ✓ Labs
- ✓ Micro
- ✓ Reports Notes
- ✓ Code Visit - not used
- ✓ Sign - disabled



10. To return to the patient list, select the "Patient List" link at the top of the display.



11. To end the session and log off the WebMT application use the "Log Off" link at the top right corner of the display.
