**Crisis and Hospital Services** Services to help connect you to supports in your community when you're experiencing a mental health or substance use crisis

### **Crisis Response**

This specialized team provides urgent assessment, intervention and referral at hospitals and community locations.

#### **Substance Use Connections**

These teams support you in hospitals and community locations. If you have overdosed, or are at risk of overdose, these teams provide a priority response.

#### **Integrated Crisis Response Teams**

If you've had a mental health or substance use emergency in Kamloops and Kelowna, these teams provide crisis response. Our MHSU clinicians partner with a specially trained RCMP officer to help connect you to the services you need to keep you safe.

### Aboriginal Patient Navigator Services (APNs-MHSU)

Our APNs-MHSU work as part of your care team. They are a resource for Aboriginal individuals and families accessing MHSU services, Aboriginal agencies, and health-care providers to ensure care is culturally safe, relevant and guided by you.

#### **Counselling and Treatment Services**

We offer group and individual counselling to people with moderate to severe mental health concerns. You can access services that may include assessment intervention, medical and psychiatric consultation, education and self-management support, referrals and outreach.

#### **Group Counselling and Education**

We provide structured group-based mental health treatment and support service. Services you can access may include counselling and treatment, coping and self-care skills, and social connections. We also offer tools to help you sustain a healthy and balanced lifestyle.

### **Perinatal Counselling Services**

If you're pregnant or a new mother, our services support you if you're at risk of mental health or substance use concerns. Our approaches focus on your safety and that of your infant.

#### **Seniors Mental Health and Substance Use Services**

If you're 65 or older and experiencing dementia and other mental health and/or substance use concerns, our teams provide specialized assessments, treatment, community support and caregiver support.

#### **Early Psychosis Intervention**

If you're experiencing your first episode of psychosis, our treatment and support services can help you develop wellness plans. We also bridge youth to adult mental health services, link community service with hospitals, and provide community education.

### **Eating Disorders Treatment Services**

If you have been diagnosed with an eating disorder, we can help by providing you with individual and group therapy. We can also sugges interventions to begin re-nourishment and promote medical stabilization.

#### **Developmental Disability Mental Health Services**

If you're 14 or older and have an intellectual developmental disorder and a mental health disorder, our teams work with you and your circ of care to promote your well-being and quality of life.

#### **Hospital-Based Psychiatry Services**

Personalized care that's focussed on enabling your recovery, empowering you, and building a sense of hope

Do you have a persistent psychiatric disorder that has not responded to treatment in other levels of care? We can provide assessment, treatment, stabilization, rehabilitation and support in a secure setting.

#### **Older Adult Assessment and Treatment**

If you're over 65 and experiencing psychiatric symptoms from dementia and/or another diagnosis, we offer assessment and treatment options.

d	Treatment, Support and Recovery If you're experiencing major mental illness and substance use concerns, we can help you with your journey to mental wellness and recovery. We provide screening and assessments, medication management and wellness plans. We can offer crisis intervention, life skills support and education, and self-management support. We also offer relapse prevention, care coordination, and referrals to volunteer and employment opportunities.
st	Intensive Case Management Our team-based care coordinates a broad range of services to meet you where you are, without judgement. We work with you to meet your needs, and connect you with supports and services to improve your health, and meet your wellness goals.
r cle	Assertive Community Treatment If you're experiencing multiple complex needs and mental illness and/or substance use concerns, our team-based approach provides client-directed care, assertive outreach and comprehensive, continuous services.

#### **Tertiary Psychiatric Services**

<b>Psychiatric Intensive Care</b> Access short-term psychiatric stabilization in a secure environment when you're experiencing complex psychiatric conditions that could pose a risk to yourself and/or others.
Adult Tertiary Rehabilitation If you have a persistent and stable mental illness, our rehabilitation program can help you reach your wellness goals, build your readiness, and develop strategies and knowledge to succeed in your community.
Older Adult Long-term Adult Tertiary Rehabilitation If you're over 65 and experiencing a serious and persistent mental illness and complex medical needs, we can provide you with specialized psychiatric care and nursing support.
