Public Interest Disclosure Act Annual Report

The *Public Interest Disclosure Act* (PIDA), B.C.'s whistleblower protection legislation, came into effect at Interior Health on June 1, 2023. PIDA provides legal confidentiality and reprisal protections to current and former employees, including medical staff, of public sector organizations who speak up about serious or systemic wrongdoing.
