EMR Data Displays

Tables

A table shows a group of related items and their values. On a table, to view a history, click on the box that contains the text name. To view details of a visit, clock on the colum header that contains the date and time.

History Screen

On a History screen within an EMR panel button, you can view the values of a data item over a period of time. The most recent data appears at the top of the table.

Graphs

A graph shows changes in numeric data (such as Red Blood Count) over a period of time.

You can graph data from panels by right clicking a test name and selecting Graph for up to a maximum of ten items. Clicking the Graph button near the bottom of the screen will display the graph

A report is detailed information of a text file sent from a source application. (Transcription, Microbiology, Pathology, or Imaging Therapeutics.) Reports contain text descriptions, codes, results, impressions, and findings.

EMR

EMR (Enterprise Medical Record) is a central location for viewing all electronically documented patient information, from all aspects of clinical care, throughout Interior Health

EMR Panels

Panel Selection Buttons (right side of window) EMR displays data in panels. A panel is a table that displays a group of data items for the selected menu option. For example, the Reports panel displays transcribed reports in the data frame for Imaging, Pathology, Health Records

Data Frame (left side of window)

This view opens once a user clicks on the EMR panel selection button. It contains data in tables for the selected visit(s) and navigation buttons. For example, Laboratory panel opens to hematology results.
