- Adults 65 years of age and older
- Residents of Extended or Intermediate Care Facilities

Pneumococcal booster doses:

- A once-only revaccination should be offered 5 years after the initial immunization to those who have:
 - Anatomic or functional asplenia
 - Sickle cell disease
 - Immunosuppression related to disease (e.g., HIV, Lymphoma, Hodgkin's, multiple myeloma) or therapy (e.g., high dose, systemic steroids)
 - Congenital immunodeficiency states
 - Chronic kidney disease
 - Chronic liver disease including cirrhosis, chronic hepatitis B, and hepatitis C
 - Solid organ or islet cell transplant (candidate or recipient)
- HSCT recipients

Vaccine products / quantities are dependent upon availability and released at the discretion of Public Health. Allow 4 business days for orders to be processed.

Maintain cold chain, biologicals will be released to those with cooler, ice packs and insulating materials.

Return expired biological to local health centre promptly, including partial vials.
