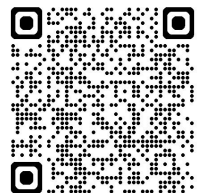
## Gloves do not replace hand hygiene.

**How to clean your hands:**

- Use soap and water if hands are visibly dirty or sticky
- Use Alcohol-Based Hand Rub (ABHR) when hands don't look dirty (preferred method of hand hygiene)
