Tetanus

Every spring we see an increase in injuries as people start cleaning up their yards/gardens. A review of the <u>Tetanus Prophylaxis in Wound Management</u> table may be good idea. You can review a patient's immunization history as recorded in the BC Provincial Immunization Registry on CareConnect.

Don't forget that when unimmunized/under immunized children present with a wound an age-appropriate tetanus containing product can be offered instead of Td. See <u>Age Appropriate Tetanus Containing Vaccines</u> to help determine the correct vaccine product to offer and the <u>Publicly Funded Vaccine Order Form</u> to order vaccine stock.

Pearls for Immunization Practice

<u>Pearls for Immunization Practice</u> is an online self-learning course for all interested immunization providers, which takes approximately 90 minutes to complete. It is especially helpful for physicians, pharmacists, and other community vaccine providers who are new to immunization practice in BC. It is also a great refresher! This course is CME accredited through UBC.

Imms Competency Course

The newly revised BCCDC Immunization Competency Course (#20112) is now live on Learning Hub.

The updated <u>BCCDC Competency Course</u> is an amalgamation of the former BCCDC Immunization Competency Courses for RNs, RPNs, LPNs, Pharmacists and Other Health Professionals and includes the incorporation of anaphylaxis management training as well as considerations for the delivery of culturally safe care within immunization programs.
