Virtual Care Quick Reference Guide - Physician Documentation in PDOC

Intended audience: Users of PDoc who currently document on acute care registered patients in a hospital setting.

Zoom Virtual Visits

A registered account in Meditech is required for documenting Zoom consultations into Meditech.

PDOC:

- 1. Search for patient via Meditech Account Number.
- 2. Click on the Document panel.
- 3. Select Clinical Outpatient.
- 4. *Select the appropriate Account Number.*
- 5. Begin Documenting.

Telephone Consultation

The Medical On-Call Availability Program (MOCAP) is a provincial program to provide responsive and sustainable on-call/availability coverage whereby one physician (the referring physician), based on his or her professional knowledge of a patient, requests the opinion of another physician competent to give advice in the field (the consultant physician) by telephone.

PDOC:

- 1. Search for patient via Meditech Account Number.
- 2. Click on the Document panel.
- 3. Select **Telephone Consult**.
- 4. *Select the appropriate Account Number.*
- 5. Begin Documenting.

Telehealth

The patient attends their scheduled telehealth visit within an IHA facility and is seen via video conference.

PDOC:

- 1. Search for patient via Meditech Account Number.
- 2. Click on the Document panel.
- 3. Select Clinical Outpatient.
- 4. *Select the appropriate Account Number.*
- 5. Begin Documenting.

Always verify that you have highlighted and selected the correct patient visit PRIOR to pressing Enter. Look at the registration date to verify
