

## **Workforce Development Agreement**

## **SERVICE USER NOTIFICATION**

Interior Health gets funding from the federal government under the <u>Workforce Development Agreement</u> (WDA) to provide work or education services. Mental Health and Substance Use centres and the British Columbia (BC) Ministry of Health provide these services in your area.

To get this funding, Interior Health has to ask for some of your personal information, shown in the table below. Asking for this personal information is legal under sections 26(c) and 26(e) of the BC *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)*. The information is given to the BC Ministry of Health and Advanced Education, Skills and Training and to Employment and Social Development Canada so they can check if these services are helping people reach their work and education goals. The Government of Canada does not use this information for any other reason.

The privacy and security of your personal information is important to us. All the information goes into a secure database and the information is securely sent to the BC Ministry of Health every three months.
